School policy states that if a child does not have their PE kit them on the day of their lesson, that they still have to take part in the lesson, wearing a kit provided for them.


We seem to have a few children in each class just now who often do not have their kit in school.

This will mean that children will have to come around to the main entrance if they are late. Mr Thomas has to lock all the school gates and cannot be asked to bring children through. Sorry!


After School Clubs
