It was an incredibly moving and thoughtful service which made an impact on everyone who attended.


The two minute silence was a perfect moment of respect for those who gave their lives for our country.


We have been remembering the 100th anniversary of the armistice of the Great War which is on Sunday, November 11th, 2019 - the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month.

November is the Month of Remembrance

All throughout November the Church remembers those who have died and prays for them. The month begins with All Saints Day where we remember all of the Saints and think about how we can follow their example of ordinary people living as God asked them to.

For the rest of the month it is a time for reflection and prayer.


