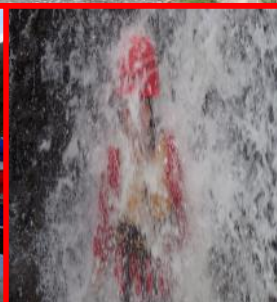

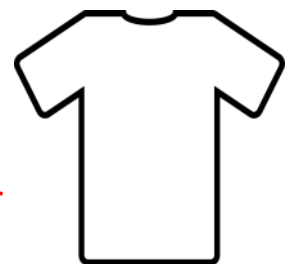


Josephine completed The Big Read Challenge this summer too. Here she is with her medal and certificate. Congratulations, Josephine!

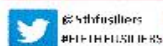
