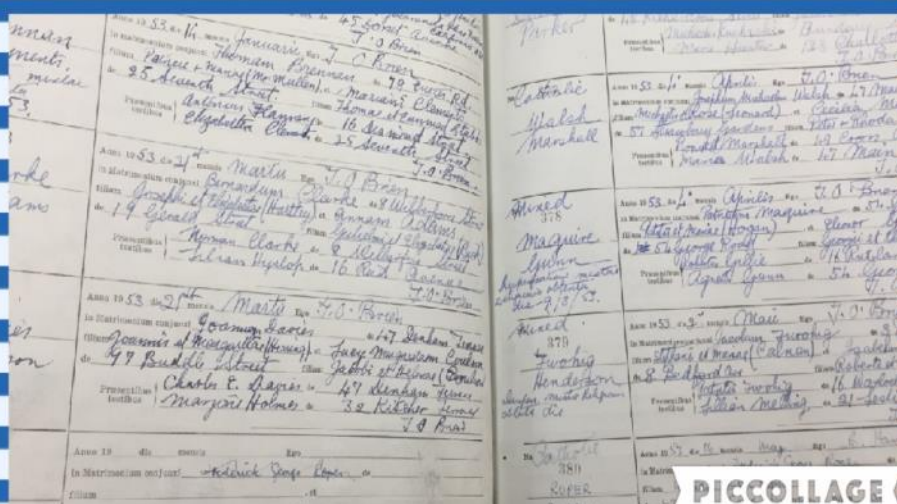
Our brilliant cook Dot is planning to hold a monthly raffle.

We will have no idea when that day will be as a different date will be chosen each month.

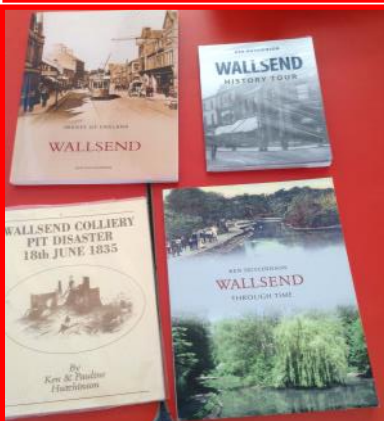
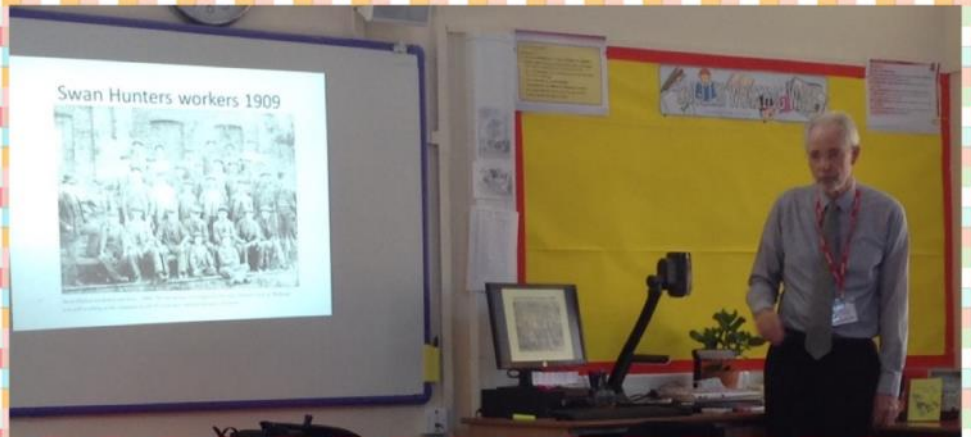
So the more regularly your child stays for lunch, the more chance they have of being in with a chance of winning.

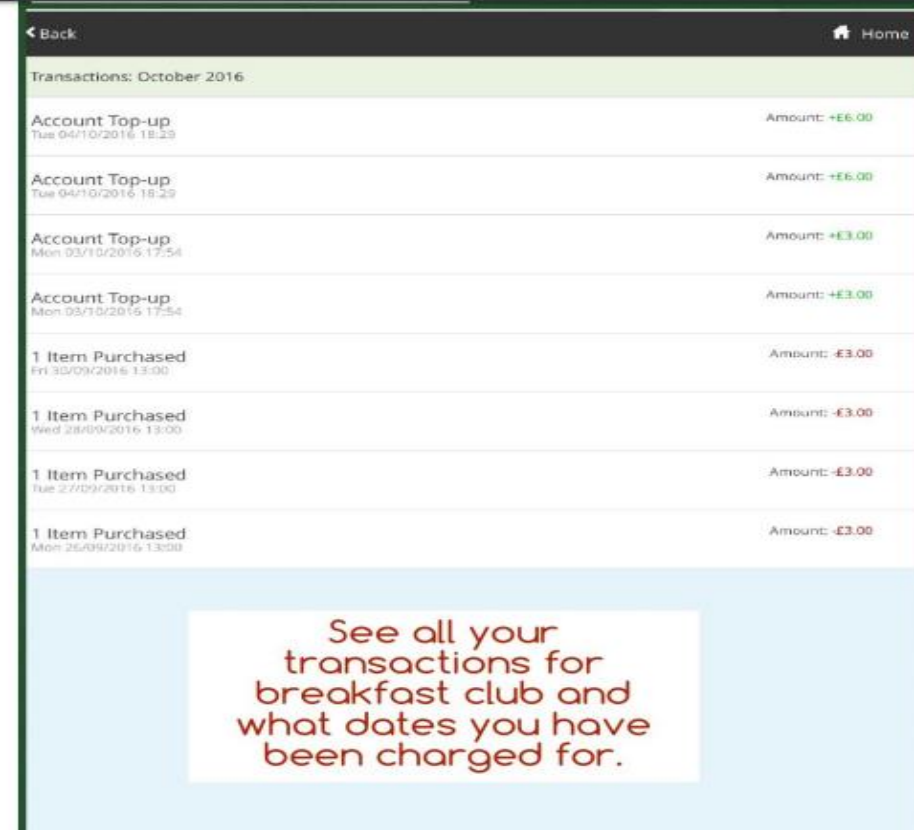
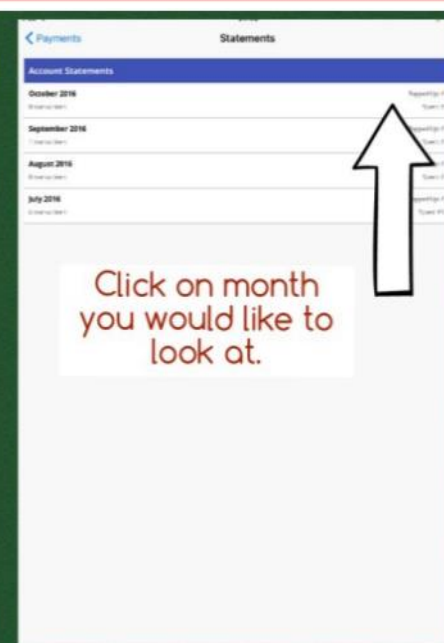
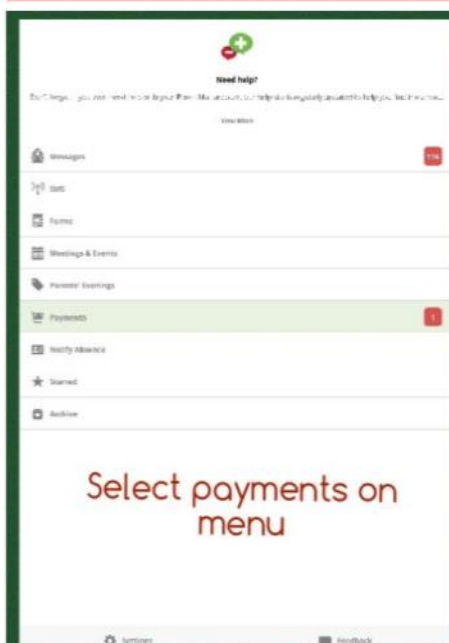
