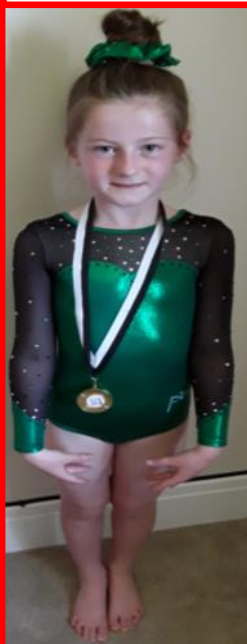

Jessica and big brother Matthew have even more trophies to add to their collection now. These are their players awards for football. Well done!



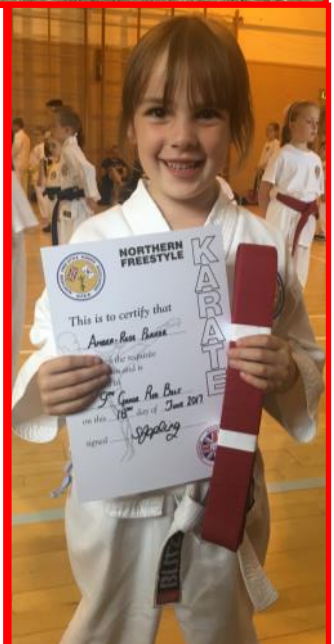
Freya won Gold in her first ever gymnastics competition. What a brilliant start... Well done!
