


# Sports/Achievements Page

Ewan recently passed his grading for his Tae Kwon Do and now has a black stripe belt (which is one belt away from black belt) Terrific stuff!




Emily and Joe both received swimming awards this week. They brought their certificates in to share with us. We are so proud of you both. Well done!
