Daniel was delighted, to be make history, when he was made the first ever Wallsend RUFC Under 9s Player of the Year. Congratulations, Dan!






Jamie received not one but two trophies this week from Whitley Bay Boys Club. Most Improved Player and an award for playing in every match. Great stuff, Jamie!
