Mrs McGuigan and Miss Clark could not have been prouder of them all as they sang songs, showed off their work and spoke about their favourite Nursery moments.

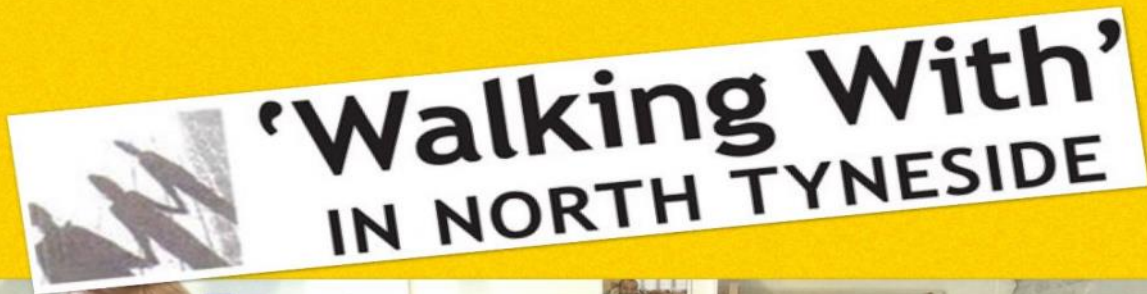

Gates Times



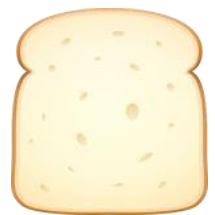
The gates to school will not be opened until 8.40am as we use the outside space for clubs before school.

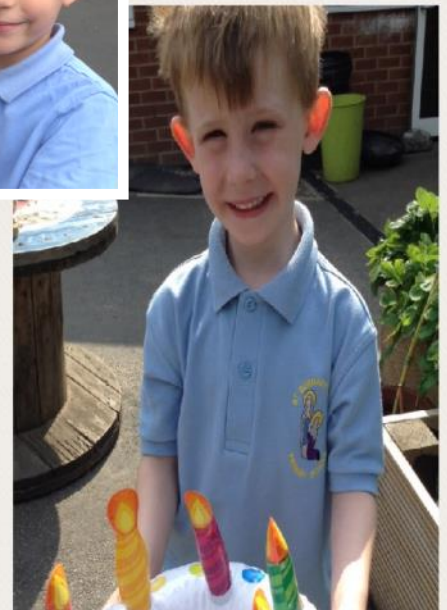
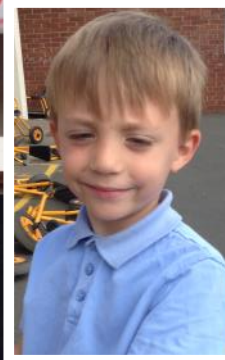
