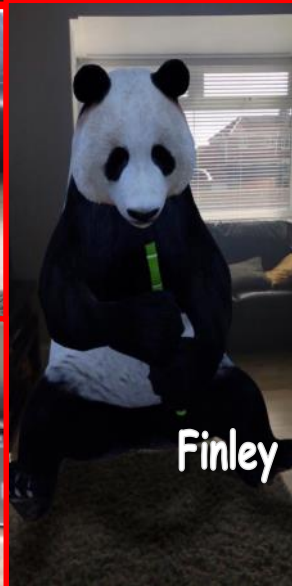
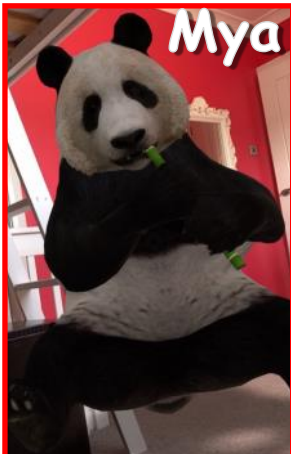
One more very special moment to share!

Isaac has been finding out all about kangaroos for his teacher. Judging by this photo-they're enormous!



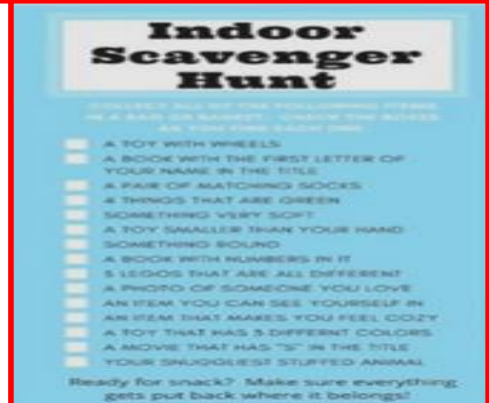
Phoebe and Isabel got their week off to a calm start with a yoga workout*. Well done, girls!



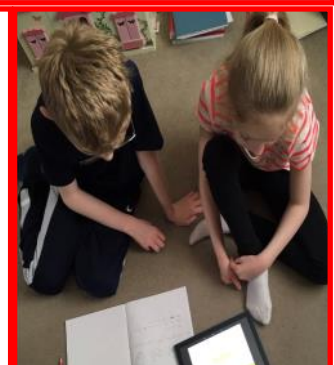
Jamie, Jenny, Mia and Alyssa made these works of art out of items that they found in their gardens.*
