

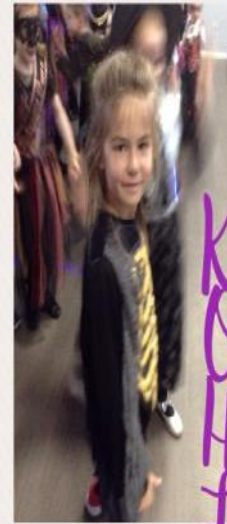


KS2 Hallowe'en Fun

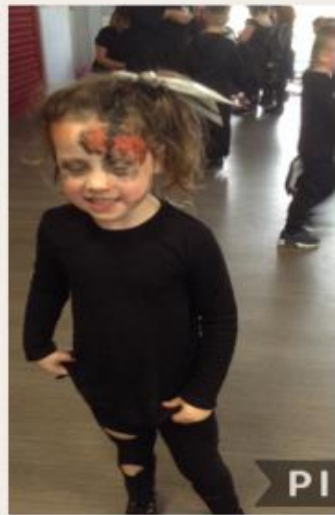
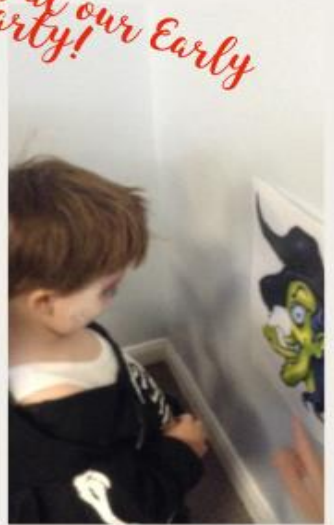

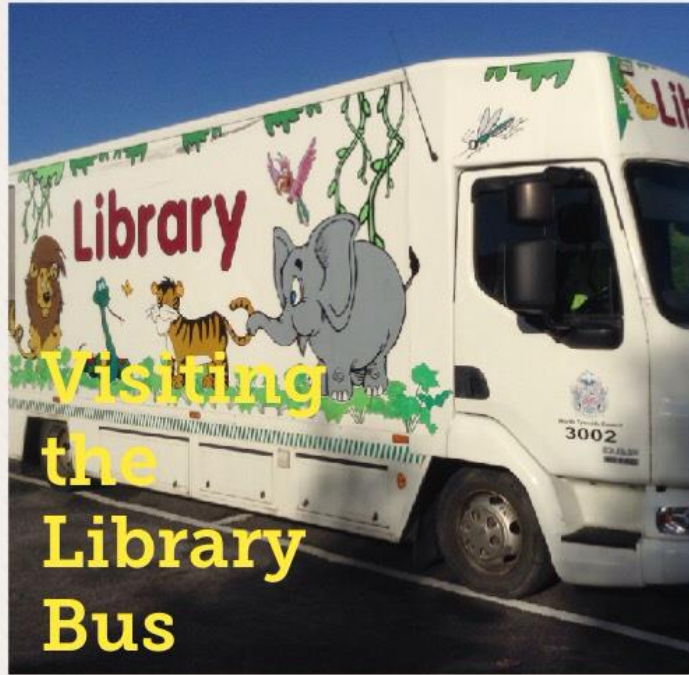
School Lunch Treats-No Tricks!



- NEVER PUT FIREWORKS IN YOUR POCKET!
- KEEP PETS INDOORS!
