On Monday, we held a very special day in school which centred on the experiences of refugees. Margaret Hodgson, a volunteer for CAFOD launched the day with a truly powerful assembly which took our children on their own journey of learning to understand that forced out by war, poverty or persecution, millions of people across God's earth, face uncertain lives as migrants and refugees. Each class then made a mini pilgrimage around a series of prayer stations. They followed the Lampedusa Cross. Francesco Tuccio is a carpenter from the small Italian island of Lampedusa. When hundreds of refugees who were fleeing Eritrea and Somalia drowned off the coast of Lampedusa, he was moved to gather the driftwood from the wrecked boats and turn them into crosses, which he offered to survivors as a small but powerful symbol of hope. 
Books will be on sale before and after school each day until Friday morning.
