We would love KS2 children to come along and sing!

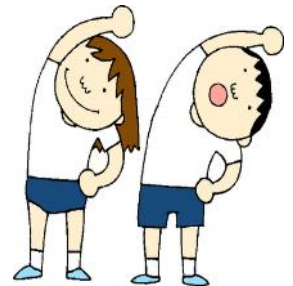


Discover Fitness

A generation ago 70% of us walked to school, now its less than half.

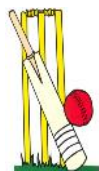
Why not encourage the kids to swap the school ride for a school stride?

Ellie's took part in her first football tournament for Wallsend & her team won.

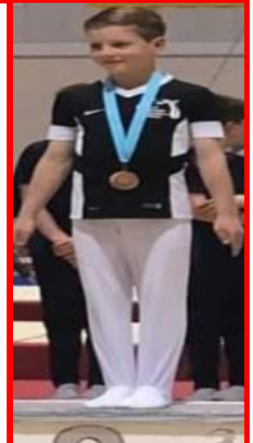
They played amazing all weekend at Flamingo Land and kept their nerves in the final-even after penalties.
