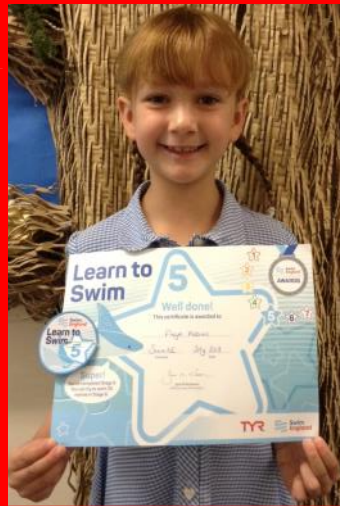
Even More Sports and Achievements
