# Literacy

We will be completing a creative writing unit based on the story, Hermelin the Mouse Detective by Mini Grey. We will begin by studying how the text is organised on the page and how information is related within the text.

We will be writing descriptions of characters and settings and thinking about how they behave and inferring what they might say and do.

We will be writing and solving our own mysteries and using our knowledge of narratives to write these short stories. We will be writing short information texts on Mice and learning to write in this factual, formal style.

We will be reading The Journey by Neil Griffiths and Scott Mann.

We will begin by studying how the text is organised on the page and discuss the word choice of the author. We will make a boat and write our own instructions.

We will read non-fiction texts about boats and create our own fact files.

We will be writing descriptions of characters and settings .

We will be writing our own stories about a journey.

#### Spelling,

#### Phonics, Grammar and Punctuation

We will be teaching the age expected spellings as well as revisiting phonic patterns and tricky words.

We will be learning about adverbs and contractions as well as using correct punctuation consistently. Across Key Stage 1 we will be continuing our daily phonics lessons. Children will work in mixed phonics groups and there will be ongoing assessment to ensure the chil-

dren are accessing the relevant phonics programme.



## Year 1/2 - Summer 1

From A-B (All about Transport)



#### Science

This half term we will be learning about We will begin work on fractions. We will recognise, find and name Materials.

We will be identifying plastics and forces including recyclable materials.

#### Homework

In Key Stage 1 the children will have homework books which will include a note each week which sets out the homework and when it should be returned. The homework will focus on basic skills, number, handwriting and sometimes topic

#### Maths

#### (For Year 2 see green for Year 1 see red)

We will be focusing on Number and Place Value; investigating the value of each digit from ones, tens and hundreds.

We will be using this understanding to solve addition and subtraction problems.

We will work to recognise, find, name and write fractions and of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity; 1/3, 1/4, 2/4, 3/4

We will write simple fractions for example,  $\frac{1}{2}$  of 6 = 3 and recog-

nise the equivalence of  $\frac{2}{4}$  and  $\frac{1}{2}$ 

We will compare and sequence intervals of time and know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day. We will learn to tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times

We will be focusing on Number and Place Value; counting, reading and writing numbers to 100; counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10; identifying the number one more and one less than a given number. We will be using this understanding to solve simple number prob-

1/2 and 1/4 of shapes and amounts.

We will tell the time to the hour and half past. We will also solve problems related to time.

As a Catholic school we follow the Diocesan scheme of work, 'Come and See' Topics this term include Holidays and Holydays and Being Sorry.

In Holidays and Holydays children will discuss their own holidays and what makes them special. We will then find out about the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.
