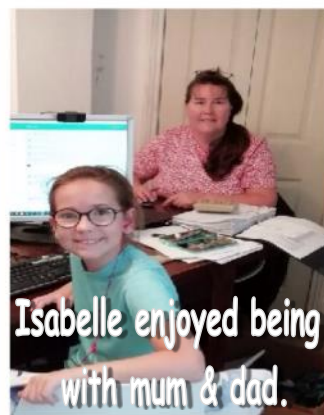

Jayden took time out from his visit to the beach to undertake a litter pick. Fabulous!! Well done!

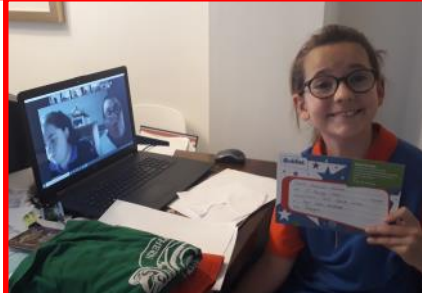
Matthew has been busy planning a preparing a surprise party for his gran's birthday. Good stuff! Bet she loved it!

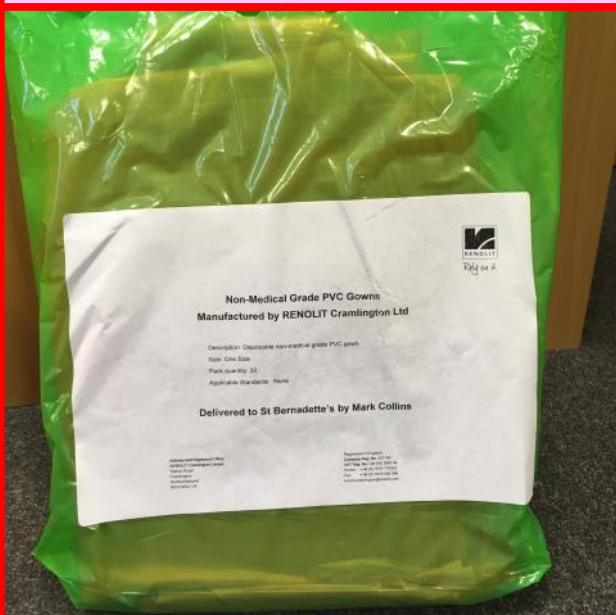
