Finally, the gang's all here...well almost!

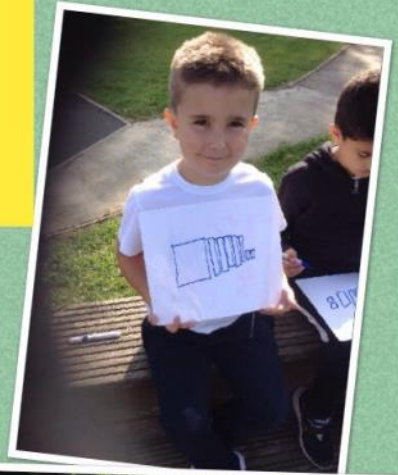
Miss Kincaid and Mrs Walker have been delighted to see how well our new Reception children are settling in. It's like they have always been here!

Sports Awards and Achievements



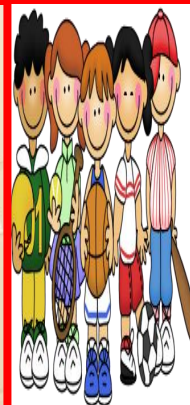

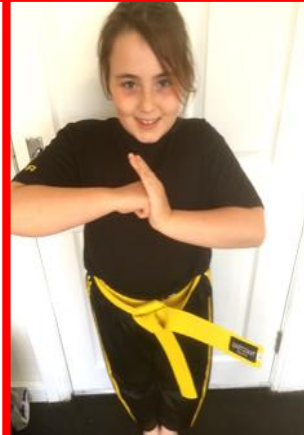


Many congratulations to Bobby! He was named "most outstanding player" of his football league. That's brilliant, Bobby! Good luck for the new season!

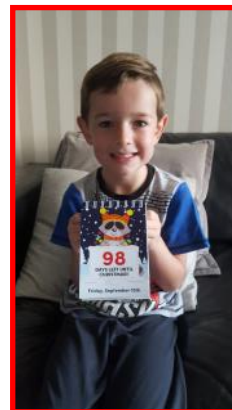
