Mrs Milner will be using the work created to make her Friday afternoon Celebration Assembly Video on Facebook.



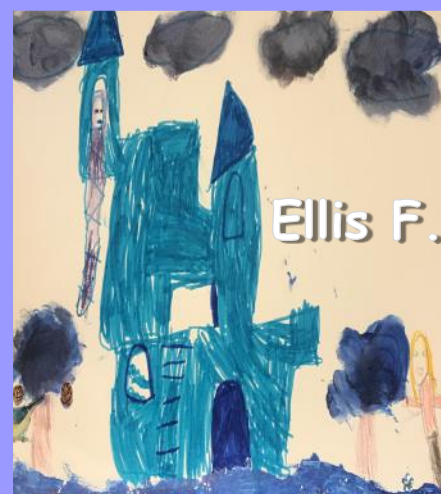

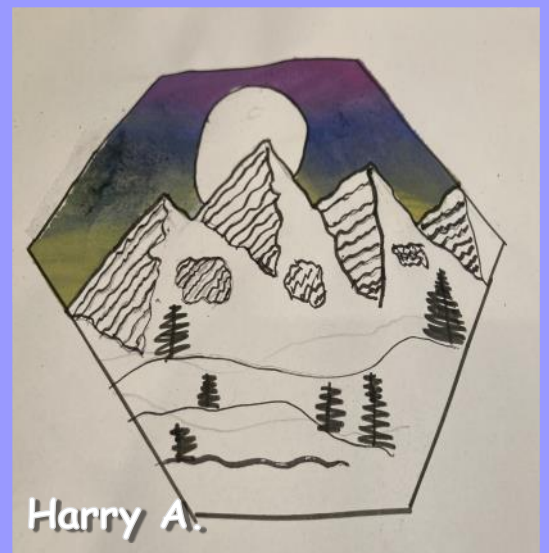

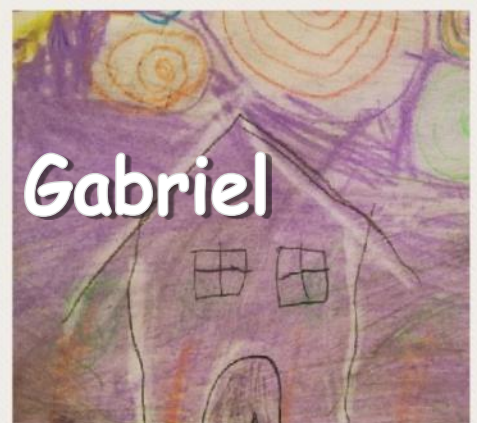

We shall be celebrating **Winnie The Pooh Day.**

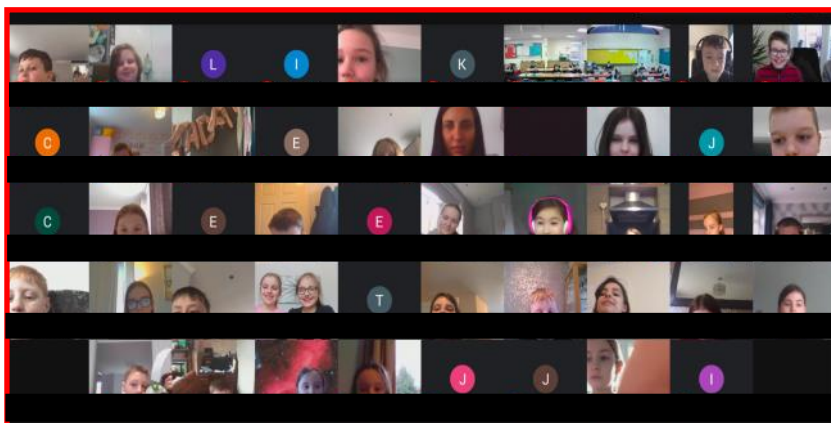
